Plans were also furthered to present a program for the Women's Club of Torrance at their May 14 meeting.


The next meeting will be on Thursday, April 30, at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Dolley.

P. E. Spends \$17,000 on Vacation Center

In contemplation of the early opening of the Pacific Electric Railway's employees' vacation camp near Lake Arrowhead, work will be begun next week on \$17,000 worth of improvements to provide still greater comforts and recreational pursuits for the hundreds of employees who spend their annual vacation in the company's mountain retreat.

Among the improvements to be started are the construction of ten mountain cottages; construction of new trails, road, nooks and fence; improvement of social hall; purchase of five rowboats; shelter for automobiles; and overhauling of 25-passenger motor launch.

The railway in 1917 purchased a picturesque site of 14 acres in the San Bernardino mountains, where employees at less than operating costs can enjoy their annual vacations among restful and scenic mountain surroundings.

Improvements have been added each year, and the camp, now representing an investment of about \$80,000, is rated as one of the best in this vicinity.
