Hope High as First Seepage of Oil Picked Up at 91 Feet

The Garner Oil Company's Keystone No. 2 was spudded in Saturday near Amelia street between Harbor boulevard and Figueroa street. Drilling went forward with No. 1 standard tools, heavier than were used on Keystone No. 1. The log of No. 2 well is correlating nicely with that of No. 1 and Mr. Garner is optimistic regarding the prospects of bringing in a shallow producer. The first oil seepage formation was picked up at 91 feet.
