

Q. Are Fur Rabbits something new, or have they a sound established market in the trade?

A. Not only is the market soundly established, but the demand for such skins is increasing every year in the trade. Up to the present time and for many years to come foreign rabbit breeders are reaping the benefit of the tremendous demand of America's fur trade, as practically all skins from American fur rabbits have been used for local manufacture in the vicinity of the breeder and very few have reached the larger fur markets, such as New York, Chicago, and St. Louis. To cite a few instances, France, Belgium, Germany, China, and Japan ship annually some 5,000,000 white rabbit skins to New York City alone. Chinchilla rabbit skins are imported from France and England in ever-increasing quantities. Blue Beveran (similar to American blue) skins are shipped by the thousands from Japan, China, England, Belgium, and France. French Silver skins come mainly from France and command high prices in New York markets.
