Boy Scout Handbook Readers Number More Than 5,000,000



New York—Heralded as the most widely read boys' book in the world and further reputed to rate next to the Bible in annual book distribution in this country, a new Handbook for Boys will be issued next week for the 650,000 lads who constitute the membership of the Boy Scouts of America. The book has been produced after years of study to determine what will most help boys to help themselves. Leading educators of the United States have considered the problem, looking to the compilation of a book which would at once interest and instruct boys and at the same time direct their activities along lines in keeping with the Boy Scout program of character building and training for citizenship duties. The cover design was drawn by Norman Rockwell, famous illustrator, who has depicted an idealized boys' head, surrounded in background, with heads of famous Scouts and pioneers including Daniel Boone, George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt and newest of this great group of Scouts and pioneers, Charles A. Lindbergh. In previous form the Boy Scout Handbook ran through thirty-seven editions and more than 3,000,000 copies were printed. For many years it has gone through the presses at the rate of 200,000 each year. Five million boys have learned their first lessons in the arts of woodcraft and handiwork from its pages. The first edition of the new Handbook will exceed 300,000 copies with immediate reprintings to follow.

"Wildflower" Is Shrine Musical Show This Week

"Wildflower," a story of Italy, is the third of the Al Malajah Temple series of light operas being presented at the Shrine Civic Auditorium, Los Angeles.

No less than four talented artists have collaborated in the composition of this great opera. Otto Harbach, famous as a lyricist, and Oscar Hammerstein II, of the illustrious New York theatrical family, wrote the book and lyrics, while the music is composed by Rudolf Friml, one of the greatest, in collaboration with Vincent Youmans, a most promising composer.

The play originated at the Casino Theatre in New York, and was staged first by Arthur Hammerstein in 1922, with the charming Edith Day in the leading role. It took with the Gotham theatre-goers at once, and played for a long time to crowded houses.

The title song, "Wildflower," is perhaps the best known of all the song hits of the piece, although there are many that vie with it in tunefulness and lilting rhythm. Ralph Braille, America's greatest native trained tenor, will have a prominent part. Charles Woodruff, who scored so sensationally in the title role of "The Merry Widow" and again in "Katinka," also will play a role in "Wildflower." Louis Templeman, the dashing Prince Danilo of "The Merry Widow," is another.

Eva Olivotti, who played with the original cast on Broadway, has been engaged for a leading part in "Wildflower." Cora Bird, well known to local theatregoers, will also be seen in a prominent part. The locale is Italy, and the story concerns love and intrigue among high Italian folk.

Others in the cast are Richard Powell, John Cherry, Lola Perdue, Roland Woodruff, George Kuinkel, Beth Laemmle, Hazel Henderson, Ethel Jenks, Pauline French and Alexander Gill.


