

## Lay Cornerstone of New Edison Office Building



The cornerstone of the new limit-height general office building of the Southern California Edison Company Ltd., at Fifth Street and Grand Avenue, Los Angeles, was laid today by John B. Miller, chairman of the company. The ceremony marked the thirty-fourth anniversary of the founding of the West Side Lighting Company, predecessor of the Edison Company. The photograph shows Mr. Miller, the new Edison building under construction, the building as it will appear when completed, and the office and plant of the West Side Lighting Company.

Marking the thirty-fourth anniversary of the incorporation of the West Side Lighting Company, predecessor of the Southern California Edison Company Ltd., John B. Miller, chairman of the Edison company, today laid the cornerstone of the new Edison general office building at Fifth street and Grand avenue, Los Angeles. The ceremony was attended by officers and directors of the company, department officials, several of the division and district managers and the building architects and builders. The group included a number of men who with Mr. Miller were pioneers in the electrical industry of the West and who hold the distinction of being Edison "twenty-five year men."

Mr. Miller, using a silver trowel, cemented the solid granite cornerstone into place. The ceremony at the new building was brief. Mr. Miller spoke of the incorporation of the West Side Lighting Company on June 5, 1936, and said that the difference between the magnificent building under construction and the small, one-story frame office and plant of the West Side company typified the great advancement of the electrical industry in Southern California. The continuity of the longstanding and progressive policy of the company has been unbroken during the many years of its history, and the spirit of loyalty and service of the employees of the company today is as strong as in the days of pioneering, Mr. Miller said.

## Council Doings

On request of the Redondo City Council, that section of 130th street between Beryl avenue and the Redondo city limits was changed to Redondo Beach avenue to conform with the continuation of the street in Redondo Beach.

American Legion was granted the exclusive permit to sell fireworks on the streets of Torrance between June 30 and July 4, inclusive.

Mrs. M. E. Atterbury of 203 Camino Real was granted a license to sell tobacco and candy from a wagon stationed at the intersection of Hawthorne avenue and Camino Real, which is the "S" turn in Hawthorne boulevard near Walters.

A request from the Clifford F. Field Company that future maps of Torrance omit the name of "Torrance Beach" at the Hollywood-Riviera tract was referred to the Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Marlow of the realty company explained that his company had spent nearly three million dollars improving the subdivision and popularizing the name "Hollywood-Riviera" and requested that references hereafter to the mile of beach in Torrance be made to the tract name and not "Torrance Beach."

Whenever Sepulveda boulevard is put through, the Torrance City Council has agreed to change the name of Camino Real to Sepulveda boulevard, which is the route of the proposed main artery connecting the San Fernando valley with Orange county. The action was taken on request of the Regional Planning Commission.

The Council authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to dispatch a letter of welcome to residents of the McDonald Tract, which this week annexed to the City of Torrance.

The new general office building, Mr. Doolittle said, will afford a complete demonstration of the use of electricity in modern office buildings. Electricity will be utilized for all lighting, heating, ventilating and power purposes throughout the thirteen-story structure. In the use of electricity for the operation of the ventilating system, the temperature control will be entirely independent of outside air conditions. A constant, pre-determined temperature with the proper percentage of humidity will be maintained. A special study has been made to provide the new building with the best types of lighting, to assure the most satisfactory illumination for varying conditions of occupation.

All Los Angeles departments of the Edison company will be quartered in the new home. At the present time, as a result of the growth of the organization, a number of departments are using buildings other than the general offices at Broadway and Third street, which first were occupied by the company in 1918. Approximately 275,000 square feet of floor space will be utilized by the various departments with their 1,200 general office employees.

The new building occupies a site 175 by 175 feet at the northwest corner of Fifth street and Grand avenue, opposite the Los Angeles central public library, and the natural contour of the site is adapted admirably to the typically American set-back style of architecture. The exterior finish will be granite, limestone and terra cotta.
