**SUPERVISOR QUINN PLAYS SUMMERTIME SANTA CLAUS**

Supervisor John R. Quinn, candidate for election from the Fourth District, swung into the final stages of his campaign today with a clarion call for better County government.

He declared himself in favor of complete and non-political investigations of all county activities which are being questioned. He went on record against salary increases to county employees. He came out strong against "invisible government."

"I have been supervisor for about three months" said Mr. Quinn. "In that time I have learned much about the county government. Some of it is good. Some is not. Several weeks ago I declared that I would oppose any increase in the county tax rate this year. When it was proposed by others that the rate be increased I opposed it with all the power at my command. When I say that I believe in economy, I mean what I say. I am convinced that county expenditures may be reduced in some county departments. If they can, I intend to use my energies to see that they are.

Increases for county employees at this time. I have told many seeking such increases that they ought to be glad that they are on the payroll at all when so many of our citizens are out of work. I favor complete, non-political investigations of all departments and county activities which are under fire. This includes flood control, the county hospital and any other branch which has been questioned by the people. I believe that all such investigations should be complete and not partial and should be conducted by legally constituted agencies," Quinn said.

Mr. Darnell, who was 58 years of age, had been falling in health for several months. He was taken to the sanitarium about three weeks before his death. **Avalon Blvd. To Be Finished Soon**

\$270,000 Is Deposited for Work; Bids Asked

All money necessary to complete the remaining portion of Avalon boulevard in Wilmington is deposited; all deeds are signed and in escrow and advertising for bids on the work began Monday to continue for three weeks, according to information from Secretary J. W. Weighman, of the Chamber of Commerce.

Construction work on the unfinished part of the boulevard, amounting to approximately three and one-half miles, is expected to start within a month and will be pushed to completion before wet weather commences. \$270,000 is on deposit to pay for the work, which also includes a concrete bridge to be built over the Nigger Slough storm drain. The paving will be of nine-inch concrete with a five-inch sub-base of disintegrated rock.


