

## Explorer To Search Mayan Ruins In Blimp



Robert S. Stacy-Judd, internationally known explorer, above, who announced in Los Angeles recently that he would leave December 1 to hunt lost cities of the Mayan civilization in Yucatan, flying in a small dirigible. The carved ruins in the background are known as "Casa de las Monjas" at Uxmal, generally regarded as the most beautiful Mayan architecture in Yucatan. Stacy-Judd said an airplane was unsuitable for exploration work but that a dirigible will allow the scientists to hover over a spot, directing ground parties. He will work in conjunction with the Pacific Geographical Society.

## Armistice Day Celebration At Olympic Stadium Is Outlined

Step out for America on Armistice Day! This stirring message is being broadcast throughout Los Angeles county by 12 posts of the American Legion, assisted by other veteran and patriotic organizations, in preparation for a huge patriotic demonstration to mark the celebration on November 11 at Olympic Stadium of the thirteenth Armistice Day anniversary.

Challenging European influences, whether Communist or Fascist, which are actively seeking to make this country a political battleground, the citizens committee of 100, in charge of arrangements for the joint celebration, asks that everyone believing in America, her government and institutions to participate in the observance.

Lieutenant Commander L. B. Ard and his committee, formed from among veteran organizations and civic groups, are confident that an audience which will fill the stadium structure to overflowing will witness the presentation of the most elaborate and outstanding program in the history of the national holiday. Some 10,000 persons will be in the procession to move through Exposition park into the stadium where high ranking officers of the army, navy and marine corps, and state and city officials will take the salute of the paraders.

Program At Historic Hour  
Prominent figures in military, civic, business and professional life, including a number of motion picture celebrities, will participate in the observance. An invitation for General John J. Pershing, commander of America's World War armies, to attend has been wired to the warrior at his home in Lincoln, Nebraska. Invitations have also been extended to former governors and lieutenant governors of the state.

The patriotic exercises will be staged in the stadium commencing at 11 o'clock sharp, while the parade in which there will be marching contingents of sailors, soldiers, marines, college and high school cadets, and veterans and patriotic organizations throughout the country, will move promptly at 12:00. The program is being presented in the morning this year




