Crippled Child Aid Sought By Service Clubs

DeKalb Spurlin Heads Local Committee to Organize Needed Work

To provide every crippled child in Los Angeles county with the opportunity of eventually becoming self-supporting, rather than a potential charge on the state, the service clubs of Los Angeles county are conducting a survey of this problem throughout the county. Under the auspices of the Crippled Children's Society of Los Angeles county, each community of the county is being represented by a local crippled children's committee, composed of one representative from each of the service clubs, fraternal organizations, as well as from the parent teachers associations and federated women's clubs.

Edward B. DeGroot, president of the Crippled Children's Society of Los Angeles county, announced yesterday that DeKalb Spurlin will head the crippled children's committee of Torrance, representing the Rotary Club. Additional members of this committee will be announced as soon as appointed by their respective organizations.

"The Crippled Children's Act of 1927, part of the California political code, was originally sponsored by the service clubs of California. To take care of our handicapped children," said DeGroot further, "and it is our desire at this time to have each community in Los Angeles county ascertain the scope of its own problem."

"We have been confronted with the seriousness of the situation by reports from the County health department that approximately one thousand crippled children in the county were without adequate medical attention. It is to signalize the gravity of this situation," said DeGroot in conclusion, "that the Crippled Children's Society of Los Angeles county has enlisted the cooperation of the various service organizations in conducting this survey."

Further details and additional information as to those children eligible may be secured locally by contacting DeKalb Spurlin, chairman of the local crippled children's committee.
