## Danger In Flying Kites To Children

A warning of the possibility of danger to children flying kites was issued here today by C. C. Bartlett, manager for the Southern California Edison Company in this territory.

"Observance of a few simple safety rules," he said, "will detract nothing from the pleasure of kite flying and will eliminate much of the hazard in this popular springtime sport.

**Kite Season Here**  
"With the coming of spring each year kite flying season again rolls around. And each year the electric companies, telephone companies and streetcar companies throughout the country again stress the warning that children should keep their kites away from the overhead lines.

"Children should not fly their kites where there is any likelihood of their coming in contact with any electric lines. It should be remembered that the kite string is at an angle and may pass over the electric lines a long distance away and entirely out of sight.

**Call the Lineman.**  
"It is also very important that should a kite become entangled in electric wires no attempt should be made to remove it. Under no circumstances should a child climb a pole in an attempt to bring down a kite. The proper thing to do is call the electric company, telephone company or streetcar company to which the wires belong. Linemen with proper equipment will be sent to take the kite from the lines. It is unsafe to try to pull down a kite which has become entangled in electric lines. The wires may be pulled together causing a short-circuit. It can happen in such cases that wires break and fall to the ground causing serious injury to anyone who may be near them.

**Metal Cord Banned**  
"In making or flying a kite no metal or metallized cord should be used. It is dangerous to use wire or lined cord, or the so-called Christmas cord with metal strands in it, for a kite string. Such materials are conductors of electricity. It is also important to remember that a damp string be-

ederal grant were made by Congressman C. J. Colden of this district and other San Pedro residents who are opposed to the outfall at White Point, according to Mayor Ludlow, who states that Congressman Colden even went so far as to contact President Roosevelt in an effort to have the PWA deny the federal grant, which represents one-third of the cost of the project.

When it became apparent that the federal aid was in jeopardy, Chief Engineer Warren made a hurried trip by airplane to Washington and was given a personal audience with Secretary Ickes to explain the merits of the outfall sewer project. It was following this interview between Ickes and Warren that a definite allocation from PWA funds was made, and early construction of the much needed sewage outlet was assured. Plans and specifications for the huge project to serve Bell, Maywood, South Gate, Compton, Willowbrook, Inglewood, Lomita, Hawthorne, Torrance, Lomita and other communities, have been drawn and ready for several months, Warren said, anticipating favorable action on the district application for the grant. Employment will be given several hundred men on the task. Bids will be advertised for as soon as the necessary legal papers are signed, it was stated.

District directors at their meeting Tuesday authorized the printing of bonds, and the pushing of condemnation suits to acquire titles to certain portions of the right-of-way the values of which have been in dispute, Mayor Ludlow stated.

Of the \$1,768,000 total bond issue, \$464,000 will be issued against property in district No. 5, which includes the City of Torrance. A bonus in cash and services equivalent to approximately \$10,000 was given on the entire issue, Mayor Ludlow said.
