

**Double Barriers At Rail Crossing**

Plans and specifications were being prepared this week for installation of a double set of yielding barriers on Alameda street Dominguez Junction, following tentative approval of the board of supervisors to agree to try out a new railroad crossing device.

A double set of the barriers will be installed to prevent vehicles from crossing the Pacific Electric tracks in advance of rapidly approaching trains. One set will be automatically operated, and the other set manually operated, by the flagman in the tower.

Cost of the double installation will be \$17,500, and the formal contract will be presented to the supervisors for approval as soon as plans are prepared, according to George Jones, county road commissioner. The invention has been perfected by an engineer on the San Francisco-Oakland Bay bridges, the supervisors were told.
