 California cotton production set a new all-time high in 1936.



 The Class A meet was Jack Kent's second in the 100 and 220. Johnny Schmidt's second in the 440 and Tommy Wilkes' third in the mile. The relay team placed third.
 In Class B competition Kirkpatrick grabbed first in the 660, running it in 1:30.9; Sommers was third in the 1,320-yard run, Machizuki placed fifth in the shot put, Tony Nady, who started the season as a Class A high jumper and then returned to his normal division in the last two dual meets, leaped into a second place tie with two others, Nagel got a third in that event and the Tartar relay team won its dash.
 Three New Records
 Hata opened the Class C meet by taking second in the 50-yard dash and second in the 120-yard low hurdles; Yasunaga placed fifth in the dash; Gerner was fifth in the 660; Bill Stewart leaped into a third place tie; Buckley was fifth in the shot put and the Tartar C's took second in the relay.
 Three new Marine League records were hung up in the varsity meet. Delaney of Leuzinger ran the high hurdles in 21.7; Tatsumi of San Pedro covered the low hurdles in 21.7, and Sa Franek, San Pedro's ace leaper, high jumped 6 ft. 1 in.

H. S. Students Hear Alcohol Lectures
