13 Millions in Federal Funds For State Roads

About \$13,500,000 of the appropriation of federal funds for aid to the states in highway work during 1940 and 1941 will come to California. The measure was recently signed by the President.

California's share for regular federal aid highways will be about \$3,768,000 in 1940 and \$4,470,000 for 1941. The 1940 allotment is about \$1,000,000 less than the present annual amount, instead of the \$2,000,000 cut once threatened. The 1941 allotment is close to the current figure.

In addition, California will receive \$583,000 each of the two years for secondary or "farm to market" roads; \$750,000 in 1940 and \$1,166,000 in 1941 for assistance in grade crossing elimination; and \$1,400,000 in 1940 and \$1,900,000 in 1941 for national forest highways, roads and trails.

'Mouse Roulette' is Latest Game

OAKLAND (U.P.)—"Mouse roulette" has been introduced here. A mouse is dropped thru a hole in a glass covered roulette wheel where it scampers around the spinning wheel until it finally takes refuge in one of the slots which becomes the winning number.
