HIRAM L. BATES... a resident of this city since 1920, passed away at his home, 1828 Arlington avenue, Monday at the age of 80 years.


The family moved to Pasadena in 1887 and later to Los Angeles where Mr. Bates operated the first horse-cars, then cable cars and finally, electric railway cars.
