

17 Families in N. Torrance Face Water Shortage

No immediate relief is in sight for 17 residents of North Torrance who are facing a water shut-off as result of the failure of the Crown Water Company to continue in business. The plight of the 17 families was brought to the attention of the city council Tuesday night for the second time but no solution was found for their problem.

A report from the state railroad commission to the effect that the Crown company's well caved in because of the recent torrential rains and that the owner of an adjacent well, who had been serving the 17, was about to refuse continued service was read to the council. The Crown Company is insolvent and cannot finance a new well, it was reported.

Meanwhile, altho the territory occupied by the 17 families is within the city of Torrance and within the area served by the Moneta Water Company, that firm and other water distributors are unwilling to extend their lines to the area. Glenn Cain, acting city engineer, informed the council that his investigations during the past week developed these reasons for this unwillingness on the part of the water companies to give service: (1) one was definitely "not interested"; (2) another said extension to the 17 was "impractical because the cost would be prohibitive to any prospective patrons"; and (3) the area affected by the water problem has only one-fifth as many possible customers as needed to warrant any extension.

ANSWER TO NOTICE OF RECALL
WE, JOHN V. MURRAY, LAWRENCE V. BABCOCK, and GEORGE V. POWELL, councilmen of the City of Torrance, answer the Notice of Recall served on us on the 9th day of April, 1941.

We deny each and every charge contained in said Notice and set forth the following:

Robert Lessing was dismissed as City Judge because he was inefficient, careless, negligent, and incapable of handling the affairs of the office of Judge of the City of Torrance; that he failed to comply with the provisions of state law governing judges of the sixth class in that he did not at any time render monthly reports to the City Clerk; that he failed to properly maintain the Court Dockets; that numerous complaints were not entered and the complete disposition of cases was not shown in his dockets and a number of the dockets in his possession were and are still missing from the City offices; that numerous complaints have also been missing from his office; that due to the manner in which he maintained his records it has not been possible for any City Auditor to make a complete report on fines collected by him; that he failed to turn over immediately monies collected to the proper City officer; that on occasions he held City money in his own possession for months at a time; that the law required him to immediately turn over all monies collected by him; that there was owing, from fines collected by him, to the City the sum of \$1,789.00 representing fines collected during an eight months period which he turned over to the City only at the insistence of the then City Auditor; that the records show approximately one-third of the cases heard by him resulted in suspended sentences; that it is impossible to ascertain from his records whether or not all of the money collected by him was turned over to the proper authorities.

That members of the Council were informed by the Grand Jury that he had been guilty of a breach of law and that it was up to the Council to remove him. We voted to dismiss him as City Judge because it is vital and necessary to the interests of the people of this City that the office be handled in a careful, capable, efficient, fair and impartial manner and Robert Lessing completely failed to fulfill these requirements.
