

Sears Elected C.C. President

Dean L. Sears, manager of the Torrance branch, Bank of America, was chosen president of the Torrance Chamber of Commerce at a meeting of directors Monday afternoon. Sears succeeds R. R. Smith, who has served as Chamber president for two years.

Other officers chosen by Chamber of Commerce directors were: Max Felker, first vice-president; A. H. Silligo, second vice-president; Sherwood McIntrye, treasurer; and L. J. Gilmeister, secretary. This is the tenth year Gilmeister has served as secretary. Terms of all officers expire July 1. Other members of the board of directors include: O. A. Kresse, F. L. Parks, Harvel Guttenfelder, George Isaacs and R. R. Smith.

The Chamber's budget for the year beginning July 1, 1941 totals \$7145. It was unanimously recommended to the Torrance city council for adoption. Principal items in the budget are: secretary's salary, \$3,000; assistant secretary's salary, \$1,380; expense account of secretary, \$400; telephone and tolls, \$176; office supplies and printing, \$250; postage, \$150; payroll tax \$45; association fees, \$95; addressograph mailing lists, \$50; tax research, \$100, Christmas street decorations, flowers to new concerns, and miscellaneous civic promotion, \$1,000; repainting eleven highway signs, 5,000 Torrance folders and maps, \$500.
