

South Seas Love and Finance In "Tuttles of Tahiti"

What happens when the sailor son of a carefree Tahitian family sets out to make them all rich, forms the amusing theme of Charles Laughton's new starring film, "The Tuttles of Tahiti," which opens the new Torrance theatre tonight. Laughton portrays the lazy but likable head of the family, Jonas Tuttle, and Jon Hall is cast as the son, Chester, who brings from distant San Francisco a fighting cock that he hopes will redeem the Tuttle fortunes. Soon these part-Polynesian descendants of an old-time Yankee sea-captain find themselves penniless as a result of their bird's timidity. The havoc this makes in Chester's romantic hopes, as well as in the family finances, leads to the surprising reversal when the Tuttle boys win a fortune in salvaging a rich cargo from an abandoned vessel. Peggy Drake, Florence Bates, Victor Francen, Gene Reynolds and noted players have prominent roles in the offering, which is said to be the first film to present a realistic picture of native life in the South Seas, as directed by Charles Vidor.
