L.A. Theatres Move to Curb Vandalism

In an effort to curb the wave of juvenile vandalism and gate crashing which has plagued Los Angeles exhibitors, the Theater Defense Bureau is urging showmen to swear out complaints with the police department on all future manifestations.

Full police cooperation and strict enforcement of Los Angeles municipal code has been promised theater owners by Chief of Police C. B. Horrall, following conferences with TDB committee headed by Rodney A. Pantages.

"As a result of our satisfactory interview with Chief Horrall, all police precincts in the city are being notified that anyone without an admission ticket or proper credentials, caught attempting to gain access to a theater is committing a misdemeanor," Pantages states. "This is punishable by a fine not in excess of \$500, a six-month jail sentence, or both. The management can and is being urged to swear out complaints and press the charges, on catching such culprits.

"There has been a wave of juvenile vandalism in theaters, not only in Los Angeles, but throughout the nation, and local operators have found it necessary to take immediate and drastic action.
