Lifeguards Keep Swimmers from Polluted Area

From now on county lifeguards, in addition to their regular duties, will perform services as beach warning patrols to prevent swimmers from using those parts of the ocean front which are contaminated with sewage and now under state quarantine.

The supervisors were notified yesterday that state health officials will have the quarantined beach signs ready for distribution by the Los Angeles city and county health departments on Thursday. They are expected to be up by Friday.
