


### Local 'Waac' Wins Foreign Service Bar for Canadian Trip

### Polio Increase Noted in State

The state department of public health said today it is possible a "conspicuous increase" in cases of poliomyelitis or infantile paralysis may occur in California during the late summer and fall.

There has been an increase in cases of the disease in recent months out of proportion to normal incidence, the department indicating an even greater increase in late summer when most cases usually occur. The department also noted that the disease is now appearing among higher than usual age groups.

### Leucemia Claims Army Private

A victim of the rare blood disease, lymphatic leucemia, Private First Class T. J. Fowler died Saturday morning at a Santa Barbara hospital to which he had been removed from Camp Roberts for special treatment. Numerous blood transfusions failed to save the 20-year-old soldier.

### Lunada Bay Lots to be Tax Sold for War Workers' Homes

Los Angeles county may soon have an additional 450 new houses for warworkers erected on tax deeded lots on the shores of Lunada Bay in Palos Verdes. This was disclosed Monday when the board of supervisors sanctioned the sale of 600 tax-deeded lots in Palos Verdes by County Tax Collector H. L. Byram. The minimum sale price fixed is \$15,000. The sale will probably be held in August.


The supervisors were informed that the real estate firm of Jones-Howard stands ready to make the opening bid of \$15,000 on the 600 lots and that it has material priorities sufficient to construct between 400 and 450 new homes for war workers.
