Foreign Property Owners Asked to File Statement

Citizens of Torrance and Lomita who own any property in foreign countries were notified through their postmaster today that they must file reports of their foreign holdings with the Treasury department before Dec. 1. The notice was given by means of a poster placed on display in the postoffice.

The postmasters point out that it is necessary for the government to have as complete information as possible on the American stake abroad to assist the military authorities and the civilian governments on the fighting fronts and to bring about sound solutions of the post-war problems.

Report forms, known as TFR-500, may be obtained through commercial banks, or from the nearest Federal Reserve Bank, it was announced. Penalties are provided for those who wilfully fail to file reports.

Vastness of War Industries, Labor Requirements, Housing Shortage Told to Lawmakers

The subcommittee of the House Naval Affairs committee which held a hearing at Long Beach a few days ago was told that 209,739 persons were employed in war industries in Torrance and the Harbor area on last Oct. 25 and that this number will be increased by 43,000 by mid-year 1944.

The legislators were also informed that the housing situation is extremely critical; that the available units fall short by about 19,000; that if all the housing projects programmed are completed by next Jan. 1 the shortage will still be at least 7,000. Testimony brought out indicated that 14,000 additional units will be required to house the estimated 48,000 to be employed by next July will be needed at 11th District Naval District installations, of which the harbor drydocks will absorb 9,300.

Provision must be made to handle eventually in excess of 500,000 tons of cargo shipments a month at the local ports and that the personnel to handle it must necessarily be vastly increased.

The U.S. Naval Dry Docks, Terminal Island, was described as a major ship repair yard, operated along the lines of a Navy Yard. The opinion also was expressed that the Bureau of Ships would, if necessary, furnish funds for the proposed \$300,000 porton bridge to connect Long Beach and Terminal Island.

Summing up the hospital situation information was presented to show there are 922 beds in civilian hospitals in Torrance, Long Beach and San Pedro for an estimated population of 400,000. The critical housing shortage was termed "a potential health menace."

During October 101 maternity cases were handled through the Naval Dispensary in Seaside Memorial hospital. Handling of such cases at the Naval hospital at Long Beach was discussed. Virtual assurance was given that the recent request of Seaside hospital for \$75,000 Lanham Act funds to expand its facilities was given by Rep. Ed V. Izac of San Diego, chairman of the subcommittee. Tentative plans were said to call for conversion of the nurses' home and a portion of the hospital roof into wards, to accommodate 125 additional beds.

Another possibility foreseen as a result of the hearing was that of taking over some hotel rooms. It was stated that there are 19,000 enlisted Navy personnel and 2200 officers living in this area, 1153 of the latter in private housing.
