MANSLAUGHTER COMPLAINT MAY FOLLOW DEATH OF TORRANCE MAN IN CRASH

Keith R. Kolhoff, harbor division police traffic investigator with the Los Angeles Police department, said yesterday he would file application for a complaint charging Ted Rowan, 41, Long Beach, with manslaughter in connection with the traffic death of Elmer Linnet, 40, of 2324 W. 236th st., Torrance.

Linnet died Saturday night in the County General Hospital and his wife, Grace, is not expected to live, Kolhoff said. Rowan is also in critical condition in the same hospital.

According to Kolhoff, a reconstruction of the collision indicates Rowan's car struck the Linnet machine and hurled it across the intersection of Pacific Coast highway and Figueroa st. into a third machine.

A coroner's jury Tuesday at a Lomita mortuary held that Rowan, resident at 1481 Henderson ave., Long Beach, was negligent in that he failed to stop at the intersection in compliance with traffic signals.

Due to the uncertainty of the outcome of Mrs. Linnet's injuries, Kolhoff said, the charges against Rowan will not be filed for a few days.

The third car was driven by Ralph Hazelwood, 25503 President ave., Harbor City, who told the investigating officer and the jury he knew nothing other than that the Linnet car was hurled

GARDEN GRAMS

Squash Bugs

Greyish brown striped with orange, when mature, are over one-half inch long. They'll be found on cucumbers, melons and squash. Egg clusters are a shiny brown color. Best control is hand picking of adults followed by a 4 or 5 percent nicotine sulphate (Black Leaf 40) dust or a spray with two to three teaspoons of nicotine sulphate to a gallon of water. Dust or spray will be effective only on very young stages.

Fall Gardens

It's important to start a fall garden in the Antelope valley in August or at the latest in early September. Carrots, turnips, parsnips, rutabaga—all root crops—can be grown during the fall and held in the ground well into the winter. Last season some people harvested these crops fresh all winter. Golden Acre or Copenhagen varieties of cabbage and St. Valentine variety of broccoli plants set in August will mature before frost. Start onion sets in August, too.

Corn Earworm

Let's not feed sweet corn to the worms! A well illustrated circular prepared by the Department of Agriculture showing how to apply oil for control of corn earworm can be obtained at the office of the farm adviser, 808 N. Spring st., Los Angeles 12. Send in a postcard giving your name and address.

Tomatoes

Be consistent with tomato pest control. Dust with sulphur at least every two or three weeks to control tomato rust mite. Dust with cryolite or calcium arsenate as often to control tomato worms. Half and half combination of sulphur with either calcium arsenate or cryolite will control both mites and worms at the same time. To complete the picture, apply nicotine sulphate (Black Leaf 40) as a dust or spray about every two weeks to control thrips and other sucking insects. Dust should be about 8 to 10 percent and spray 1 to 600 (one and three-fourths teaspoons per gallon of water).

Schools Will Get Aid In Lunch Program

Continued federal aid to community school lunch programs in the west and throughout the nation was assured by recent congressional action in authorizing \$50,000,000 for this purpose, it was announced today by Charles W. Smith, western regional director of food distribution. "The nine western states will receive their proportional share of this total appropriation," Smith said.

"A good school lunch program is even more important to the welfare of our children in war than in peace, especially in crowded production areas, where many mothers work," Smith declared. "A good lunch at school can provide from 1/4 to 1/2 of the child's nutritive requirements for the day," he concluded.
