State Guard Recruiting Campaign Brings Many New Men to Co. H

Recruiting of men for Company H, 2nd Battalion, 39th Regiment, of the California State Guard, is under way in Torrance and Lomita, with many new men preparing to don the uniform of the United States Army in the widespread training and defense program of the company, according to Captain R. L. Lewellen, commanding officer.

Men of the company have been making a house-to-house drive for recruits, explaining the necessity for the State Guard for state and community defense.

Maintenance of the State Guard is required by act of Congress and the State Legislature; it functions under the regulations of the National Guard bureau of the War Department; it is completely equipped by the federal government with three types of uniforms, 30 calibre rifles and ammunition, machine guns and complete field equipment, and it is trained under close supervision of the United States Army, Captain Lewellen said.

Company H always has ranked as one of the outstanding companies of the Guard and men are proud to be in the unit. An effort is being made to recruit to authorized strength of 147 men.

To Fort Cronkhite Battalion staff officers and commanders of companies in the 2nd Battalion, 39th Regiment, California State Guard, are preparing to participate in State Guard Tactical School, to be held under the supervision of the United States Army at Fort Cronkhite, San Francisco. The school is being conducted by the Army to give the commanders of state troops the very latest tactical training.

Attending from the 2nd Battalion at the school of one week's duration opening Aug. 6 are Maj. A. Milton Fish, battalion commander; Capt. Chalmers M. Dulmage of Hermosa Beach, battalion executive officer; Capt. Harold F. Theinhaus, Long Beach, battalion ordnance officer; Capt. Clarence L. Johnson, Long Beach, battalion supply officer; Capt. Robert F. Genter, Compton, battalion training officer and commander of Company I, Compton, and Capt.

S. C. Sault, commanding Company D, Wilmington. To attend the school starting Aug. 27 are Capt. Lee B. Wynn of Hermosa Beach, battalion special operations officer; Capt. Charles L. Johnson, commanding Company F, Hermosa Beach; 1st Lt. George L. Maitrejean of Bellflower, battalion adjutant; 2nd Lt. M. E. Klepper, Long Beach, assistant battalion supply officer.

Community-wide cooperation is essential to build the guard to its authorized strength, it is pointed out, and since the guard is on the "front line" of defense of the state and communities, every eligible man not in the federal service and not likely to be inducted therein should take advantage of the opportunity to wear the uniform of the United States Army on the home front to serve when needed.

Beef May be Ration-Free On Aug. 13

Authoritative sources disclose that steaks and roasts from utility grades of beef will be made ration-free beginning Aug. 13, but that hams and pork loins will be returned to the ration list.

These sources said that by Sept. 1 steaks and roasts from the better commercial grade of beef also will be made ration-free.

The decision to remove utility beef from the ration list and return point values to the two pork products came with the settlement of a rationing dispute between the War Food Administration and the Office of Price Administration.

Draft of Men Over 25 Years Old Is Proposed

State draft directors have been ordered to resume drafting men over 25 who are making no contribution to the war effort.

Draft Director Lewis B. Hershey has directed them to conform to the national policy which permits deferment of men 26 through 29 only if they are "necessary men" in essential industry, and men 30 and over only if they are making a substantial contribution to the war.

Some state directors simplified this policy by ordering a "holiday" for all men over 25, regardless of jobs.

Hershey also asked for a review of all I-A's—those subject to induction—in order to remove from that class the older registrants whose jobs entitle them to deferments.



General McCoach Urges Men to Join State Guard

Eligible men in five states of the Ninth Service Command—Washington, Idaho, California and Utah—were urged today by Maj. Gen. David McCoach, Jr., Commanding General, at his command headquarters at Fort Douglas, Utah, to join the State Guards of their respective states.

General McCoach paid high tribute to "the excellent work accomplished by State Guard units in dealing with disaster relief throughout the country during the past few weeks."

He recalled the vital assistance given by various State Guard units during recent forest fires in the New England states, the destructive tornado in Pennsylvania and West Virginia and the circus fire in Connecticut.

"Local communities are looking more and more to the State Guard for assistance in time of emergency," General McCoach stated.

Interested persons should contact the commanders of their particular companies who can be reached at the various state armories.

Men honorably discharged from the Army are eligible for enrollment. Ages for enlistment are 18 to 64 and units drill one night a week, with monthly Sunday maneuvers.

There are no restrictions, peacetime or wartime, on carelessness.
