Naval V-12 program who have been assigned for specialized training at various midshipmen schools in the east as candidates for the rank of ensigns. They will be joined by 190 others who have completed their basic studies at S.C.

Following the cap and gown procession across the campus the graduates will take part in ceremonies to be conducted by President Rufus B. von Klein Smid.

Previously the Rev. Mr. Roloff had been honored by election to Phi Chi Phi, national religious fraternity recognizing outstanding scholastic achievement and notable service to the social and spiritual life of the various schools.

Roloff was the only candidate receiving the scarlet trimmed hood signifying the completion of graduate studies in theology.
