

Decrease In Claims Shown By U. S. E. S.

Kenneth E. Bradley, manager of the local U.S.E.S. office, announced yesterday that 2,617 claims were on file as of Oct. 17, showing the first decrease since V.J. day. The peak was reached Oct. 5 when a total of 2706 registrants were on file.

New claims for the past week totaled 233 with job openings standing at 584. Bradley said that 284 referrals had been made to these job openings.
