
'SHOCK ABSORBER' LAMP

Cold Sores Topic Of Dr. Swartout

Cold sores are acute, inflamed areas of skin, with red and swollen bases, more or less thickly dotted with small blisters. The blisters tend to dry up and form yellowish or brownish crusts which drop off in a week or two leaving no scars.

Physicians can give other and often more effective treatments. It has been found that the use of smallpox vaccine every week or two for several weeks will often check the tendency to repeated attacks of cold sores, although the reason why it does so is not clear.

Steel Director Commends All Industry

Irving S. Olds, Chairman, Board of Directors, United States Steel Corporation, in a year-end statement issued today, said:

"The year now ending saw the conclusion of a well-earned conflict which for more than three years taxed all of the resources of the United States. All of us can be devoutly thankful that our arms were so completely successful. American industry contributed in large measure to making possible the military successes and management shares with employees the satisfaction of a job well done.

"During the war, no project was held up or abandoned because of lack of steel. As an important unit in the steel industry, United States Steel produced 161,106,803 tons of steel ingots and castings from Jan. 1, 1940 to Aug. 15, 1945.

"Now an era of peace lies ahead. The threat of an industry-wide steel strike presently clouds the horizon. However, it is hoped that the same unity of purpose and the same determination to meet and solve problems in a manner fair to all parties involved, which prevailed during the war, will carry over into the New Year and will lead to a sound and constructive solution of this and any other future difficulties of a character affecting the public interest."

Gasoline Taxes Continue To Show Increase

Marking the tenth consecutive month that assessment of oil companies for California gasoline taxes has shown an increase over the corresponding month of 1944, R. E. Collins, chairman of the State Board of Equalization, today, following completion of review by the Board of the tax returns recently filed, announced that taxes for October, based on distribution of 181,751,265 gallons, amounted to \$5,602,637.

While October represents a loss in revenue of \$435,611 from the peak month of September when all records were broken, it is a gain of 29 per cent over October, 1944, when distribution of 144,469,680 gallons netted \$4,344,090.

General Fund Cash Excess Announced

State Controller Harry B. Riley today announced that the General Fund cash excess over current obligations on Nov. 30, 1945, was \$102,170,909, as compared with an excess of \$89,326,507 at the end of the preceding month and an excess of \$82,747,476 on Nov. 30, 1944.

The present cash excess, said Riley, represents an increase of \$12,844,402 over the excess of Oct. 31, 1945. Of this increase, \$12,844,258 represents the excess of November, 1945, revenue over November governmental cost expenditures and the remainder of the increase, or \$144, represents miscellaneous nonrevenue receipts.

General Fund revenues deposited in the state treasury during the first five months of the 97th fiscal year totaled \$133,397,392—an increase of \$26,037,086 over collections for the same period last year.

The major increases in revenue occurred in retail sales and use taxes, \$22,206,497; inheritance taxes, \$1,746,542; liquor taxes and licenses, \$1,676,429, bank and corporation franchise and corporation income taxes, \$1,224,867. These, together with other smaller increases, were partially offset by decreases in other revenues, resulting in a net total increase of \$26,037,086.

General Fund expenditures during the first five months of the 97th fiscal year as announced by Riley, totaled \$173,789,405—a decrease of \$6,344,136 under expenditures for the same period last year.
