

Right Guide

Some 55,000 veterans monthly come into the 33 VA contact offices scattered throughout Southern California. Thousands of claims are filed and thousands of applications for benefits are made through these offices.

No department of the VA is closer touch with the veteran than the contact division. It is through this department the VA has contact with veterans' needs and readjustment problems.

The following "Tips to Veterans" come directly from "Contact."

Remember that C-Number. Each veteran who has applied for some benefit under Federal law as processed by the VA is given a Claim, or "C," number. A folder is made up and everything relative to claims applications, etc., goes into the file. It is a veteran's serial and pay number. There are 261,000 such files in the records section of the Los Angeles regional office, all in numerical order. Names mean little — it's the number which counts. Veterans are urged to memorize that number, and use it always in any correspondence with the VA.

That Insurance Policy Number is likewise extremely important. Veterans and their beneficiaries should never forget that number. Use it every time payments are made or insurance benefits applied for.

Don't Wait Until the Last Minute to apply for eligibility certificate. Just before school terms open there is a great rush and jam for eligibility certificates. This causes needless delay and confusion — and sometimes delayed subsistence checks. All veterans who plan on attending school this fall should apply for these certificates NOW.

Changes in Schools or On-the-Job training must be made through the VA. Many veterans are changing school or training without notifying the VA. No subsistence checks can be sent out until a supplemental eligibility certificate has been issued, and endorsed and returned by the new school.

General Bradley has Suspend- ed Insurance. But governing reinstatement for the remainder of 1946. No physical examinations required. Change of Address. When asked by "Right Guide" what is the most important tip for veterans, nine out of ten contact representatives answered, "Change of Address." Without the new address pension and subsistence checks cannot be forwarded. Every veteran with a "C-Number" should notify the VA immediately of any change of address.

If in Doubt call Contact.

Low Price Shoe Program Greatly Aided By OPA

The Office of Price Administration took another step in its program to provide additional low-priced merchandise by granting a manufacturers' increase in the prices of certain standard low priced shoes. Depending upon the price of the shoe, this increase may vary from less than 10 to about 15 percent, with a higher percentage going to lower priced shoes.

From the consumers' standpoint, today's measure means that the retail prices of low priced shoes like those made and sold in March 1945 will be increased by the same percentage. For example, such men's and women's shoes which were retailed in 1945 in the neighborhood of \$4.30 may now cost between 45 and 65 cents more. Such children's \$2.50 shoes may go up to about \$2.75 or \$2.85. The action is effective today.
