West Basin Water Study Inspires Inquiries From Throughout Nation

The recently completed report by Harold Conkling, famous hydraulic engineer on "An Improved Water Supply for West Basin" is being reviewed with interest by universities, municipalities, irrigation districts, and city health departments in many sections of the nation.

Conkling was retained by the West Basin Water Association in March of this year to make a survey and report on the most practical, economical and safe means of obtaining a supplemental water supply for West Basin. Among others, requests for copies of the report have been received from the University of Arizona, University of Santa Clara, Michigan State College, City of San Diego, City of Claremont, Calif., City of Grand Rapids, Mich., Dept. of Health State of Pennsylvania, United States Dept. of Agriculture, War Department United States Engineers, and famous engineering firms all over the country.

Investigation and drafting of the report was prompted because fresh water levels in the basin have dropped far below sea level, permitting intrusion of ocean water into the basin with consequent danger to the entire domestic water supply of the area.

The West Basin Water Association comprising of municipal, private water company, and industrial producers of ground-water from the Basin, has made a prolonged study of the water problem of the area. Ben Haggott, president of the Association, stated: "The dire need of immediate imported water to meet the deficiency in our natural ground-water supply is recognized by all water authorities. Mr. Conkling was retained to determine the best possible means of obtaining this additional needed supply. His report should prove to be a great help to residents of the area seeking a solution to the problem."

In his report Conkling cites the use of Colorado River water through annexation to the Metropolitan Water District, and use of sterilized sewage water which would be pumped underground to replenish the dwindling ground-water supplies, as the two possible sources of supplemental supply. It is the latter revolutionary proposal that is viewed with such interest by engineers, colleges, and municipalities throughout the nation.

Four Airlines To Be Based At Inglewood Port

A \$4,000,000 building and navigational aid project is being pushed to completion at Los Angeles airport at Inglewood by the United Airlines, Trans-World Airlines, American Airlines and Western Airlines which will start intermediate facilities early next month.

The four major airlines all plan to move their operation bases to the municipal terminal, according to Joseph S. Marriott, Santa Monica, regional Civil Aeronautics Administration administrator, who said the program would cost \$2,000,000 plus an estimated \$95,000 to be spent sometime after the first of the year.

Buildings which will be constructed under the future plans include hangars, maintenance shops, general offices, stock rooms, commissaries and other miscellaneous operating facilities.

Sea Scouts in Rendezvous At Marine Stadium

Sea Scout Ships of the Los Angeles Area Council will join with the ships from all parts of Southern California for the annual Sea Scout Rendezvous at Marine stadium, Long Beach on November 29, 30 and December 1. More than 1,000 Sea Scouts are expected to participate in the various events according to Al Villaseñor, commander of the local nautical group. Villaseñor has been named to serve as general chairman of the affair according to C. J. Carlson, regional Scout executive.

Competitive events on the program will include boat maneuvers, skiff pulling, breeches buoy rescue, boat drill, boat chair hauling, and the Mariners problem.

Friday evening, November 29, a mammoth campfire program will be staged at the encampment and on Saturday evening a formal ball will be held for the participating Sea Scouts. Church services will be held on the grounds of the campsite on Sunday morning.
