County Issues Complaints To Stop Burning

District Attorney W. E. Simpson today ordered Chief Deputy District Attorney S. Ernest Roll and Deputy District Attorney Fred N. Whiehelo to issue complaints against dump operators operating dumps in the vicinity of Imperial highway, 120th and Western, in Los Angeles county. Simpson stated that investigation disclosed that the health and safety of numerous persons in the southwest area of Los Angeles county was seriously affected by the manner in which these dumps were being operated. He further stated that investigation disclosed that dumps were violating the Air Pollution Control ordinance of Los Angeles county, county fire ordinances and an ordinance which precludes the blocking of storm drains and flood channels. There is also evidence available to show that certain of these dumps are infested by rats. Simpson also stated that dump operators would be served with notices to abate a public nuisance as provided in Section 373a of the Penal Code.

Central Fire Station Here Is Condemned

Edly called to this danger, and the cracks in the building, which have been increasing in size during this time, indicate the slippage in the walls and structural members is increasing with the inevitable result that a collapse will take place at some time. This collapse may be caused by an explosion or by the building being struck by some vehicle, either of which is more probable than an earthquake, especially in our locality where industrial plants, use, store and manufacture highly explosive materials. "The collapse of any wall or member undoubtedly would result in blocking of exits from the fire station so that the only fire fighting equipment which Torrance has, except in the small substation in Waveria, would be rendered useless, with the likely injury of all or many of the fire fighting personnel on duty. "Of the approximately 65 buildings seriously damaged in the 1941 quake, the Central fire station alone remains unrepaired. All other buildings seriously damaged have been placed in reasonably safe condition, at least as far as present knowledge of earthquake design permits without complete new construction and the use of all new material. "The design of the fire station... earthquakes or other disturbances in that the structure is 'top-heavy' and is not tied together in a manner that would withstand such disturbances. "In view of the hazardous condition of this public building, housing the only fire protection that the City of Torrance has in the central business, residential and industrial district, I feel obligated to urge that immediate steps be taken to protect the lives and property of all those concerned."




