State Income Tax Returns Set April 15

State income tax returns for 1946 must be filed no later than April 15, Charles J. McColgan, franchise tax commissioner, said today.

The tax applies to single individuals who had a net income of \$3,000 or more last year or a gross income of \$6,000 or more. Married persons whose aggregate net income amounted to \$4,500 or more, or aggregate gross income of \$6,000 and upward, must file returns.

Penicillin Use In Venereal Cases Cited

The use of penicillin has proven to be the most successful treatment of gonorrhea and provides an ideal procedure for office use in general practice. Approximately 500,000 units of penicillin are given by injection into the hip muscles. By repeated examinations the doctor determines cure. These tests-of-cure are the responsibility of the attending physician and are a very important part of the treatment.

Over-confidence in the ability of this modern intensive treatment to cure venereal infections, however, creates added danger. Because both syphilis and go-

norhea may be acquired at one exposure, the shorter treatment for gonorrhea may mask, but not prevent, the slower developing of syphilis infection, 'suppressing the manifestations of syphilis so that the individual patient is unaware of the syphilitic infection. The short incubation period for gonorrhea and the long incubation period for syphilis will bring the patient to the doctor first for gonorrhea. But if penicillin is used and the blood test is negative, that patient should be under close observation by the physician at monthly intervals for at least 3 months and be warned to watch for rash or lesions. When patients have been treated for gonorrhea under

conditions where re-infection is not likely, the success rate of cure with penicillin is better than 90%. Quackery, self-treatment and reliance for help from friends are dangerous and ill-advised. Only a competent doctor can determine the presence of the disease and treat it. Clinics are open to those who cannot afford to pay private physicians. Information regarding these clinics can be obtained from the local health department.


