Auditorium Use One Night Free Denied Veterans

Torrance City Council again Tuesday night denied the Veterans of Foreign Wars post here free use of the Civic auditorium, even for one night. Vern Coll, commander of the post, declared that the scale of rental fees set up by the Council is prohibitive, and requested use of the auditorium for a joint installation of officers of the Post and auxiliary. He said both the V.F.W. and American Legion had moved to the C.I.O. hall for regular meetings, because of the high rent being charged, but that the C.I.O. hall is not large enough for the colorful installation of officers. Councilman W. H. Tolson moved that the free use be granted, but the other councilmen remained mute and the veterans lost.

Carlson, chairman, Joint Legislative Council of the Railroad Brotherhoods and Bill Belton of the CIO Veterans Committee, asked all interested parties to write to Senators Downey and Knowland urging them to vote No on the bills in question, claiming that the bills are aimed at smashing the labor unions.

Five Arrests In Three Rape Cases During Week End

Five arrests in three cases, two for assault with intent to commit rape and three for actual rape, were made by the Torrance police this past week-end.

Jack Harold Armstrong, 25, of Wilmington, was arrested at his home early Saturday morning on the complaint of a local girl that he had threatened her with a knife at a beach party Friday evening "if you don't do what I want."

At his hearing before City Judge John A. Shidler Tuesday, Armstrong was bound over to Superior Court for plea on May 8.

Deputy District Attorney George Kemp stated that his office would probably file a lesser charge against the defendant due to lack of evidence, and Judge Shidler reduced bail to \$500.

Richard Samuel Irwin, 22, of Compton, was arrested early Sunday morning after a report

was phoned in to the station that a woman was screaming in an alley off the 2300 block of Border ave. Investigating officers captured Irwin at the location and stated that he resisted arrest, lacerating Police Sergeant Haslam's face in the process.

At his hearing in City court

Tuesday, the case was continued to April 29 by Judge Shidler. Three juveniles who were charged with committing rape on a juvenile girl from Los Angeles Sunday morning in the vicinity of Maple ave., were turned over to the Sheriff's juvenile detail, according to police reports.
