Buddy Poppy day is in itself an annual memorial to those in Flanders Field, and now includes the beaches of Normandy, the footholds of Okinawa or any place that our men fell in battle on foreign soil.

Buddy Poppy sales have provided funds for relief work amongst veterans and dependents for a quarter century. This year the campaign carries even greater importance because of the enormous casualties of the second World War. The Army and Navy departments estimate the overall casualties at approximately 1,200,000.

All buddy poppies are made by disabled veterans in Government hospitals as their contribution to this memorial. The expenses are paid by the V.F.W. Most of the money contributed remains in the community in which it is donated and is used to provide constant assistance for those widowed and orphaned by war as well as disabled, sick, needy veterans and their families.
