LAST AIRPORT ACQUISITION HURDLE REACHED AS W. A. A. ADVERTISES PROPERTY SALE

airport under a deed would be the culmination of many months of effort on the part of the city by Reed H. Parkin, as chairman of the City Aviation Commission and president of the Chamber of Commerce, by Rep. Cecil R. King, and by members of the aviation commission. Parkin has engineered the entire project for the city, but resigned at a recent meeting of the Council when that body showed reluctance to accept the "right of entry" permit offered by the U. S. Engineers.

The right of entry permit, however, later was accepted at the insistence of members of the commission. E. Tarkington was made manager of the airport on a commission basis at that time. Considerable dissension developed at the field following the assumption of control by Tarkington, and the number of airplanes there has dwindled in recent weeks.

Tarkington, however, has solicited assistance of the Chamber of Commerce in working out a successful project for the municipality.

In a letter to the Chamber, Tarkington said:
 "The Torrance Chamber of Commerce, I understand, spent considerable time and effort in helping to acquire the Lomita flight strip for the City of Torrance."
 "It is the earnest desire of the undersigned to again engage their interest and advice in planning to make this airport the finest private flying field in the country."
 "I would feel highly honored and very flattered to have those of your membership who are truly interested in the welfare of Torrance and the development of its newly acquired airport to visit this fine property and advise me of your wishes and ideas. My time is at your disposal for an appointment."

The Chamber has replied that it desires a copy of the arrangement between Tarkington and the City Council and for a resume of the proposals of Tarkington for operation of the airport before responding.

The government's description of the location of the airport, built on land purchased from the property of the late Ben Weston, attracted considerable interest.

The W.A.A. says the flight strip is located in Torrance, on Pacific Coast highway approximately 23 miles south of downtown Los Angeles and approximately five miles northwest of Los Angeles Harbor.

Also attracting interest is the use of a Lomita postoffice address by the City of Torrance on the airport stationery of the city.

Sentence Date For McKenzie Set For July 23

Ruth Helen (Sunny) McKenzie will appear in Superior Court July 23 to be sentenced for manslaughter in the death of Jack Clifford Floyd, of Torrance, last March 12.

Miss McKenzie originally was charged with first degree murder but was allowed to plead guilty to a manslaughter charge in an agreement between her attorneys and the prosecution.

Floyd was stabbed to death in Miss McKenzie's apartment on El Prado st. in Torrance, on the night of March 12, when according to the accused's story, they were "just playing around."
