Torrance City Council Studies New County Ordinance On Low Flying

Chief of Police John Stroh recently joined other Southern California law enforcement officials in a meeting with Sheriff Eugene Biscailuz, to add impetus to the proposed new county ordinance curbing low flying and other state air navigation law violations.

The meeting was held to discuss the first rough draft of the ordinance, which went before the County Board of Supervisors Tuesday for a hearing.

Captain Sewel Griggers, of the Sheriff's aero squadron, told the officers that the need of a new ordinance was imperative, as during one recent weekend there were more than 50 complaints received on low flying. He stressed the necessity for new legislation in air flying immediately. Griggers added that the trouble was practically all with private owners of planes.

Torrance is particularly interested in the proposed ordinance, and in considering a companion city measure, since the area of Torrance is of nearly 19 square miles, third largest city in the county, and since Torrance possesses two

airports, Community Airport at Prairie ave. and Redondo Beach Blvd., and Torrance Municipal Airport on 101 highway and Crenshaw Blvd.

Sheriff Biscailuz asked that every Police head in Los Angeles County appoint an aero detail to work with the Sheriff's squadron in enforcing the new law if it is enacted into a law.

H. W. Kennedy, county counsel, read the first rough draft of the proposed ordinance and said that he would welcome suggestions from any of those present regarding changes and amendments. He added that he wanted the various municipalities in Los Angeles County to have the same ordinance so that all law enforcement agencies could work in unison in enforcing it. Kennedy emphasized that it would be necessary that every separate municipality adopt the ordinance as the Board of Supervisors could only have jurisdiction over the unincorporated areas. District Attorney William E. Simpson said that he would have a special committee in his office to work on the prosecution of the new air navigation law violations.


