Gen. Thomas Air Pollution Group Leader

Further activating the Air Pollution Control District, the Board of Supervisors, at its Tuesday meeting, authorized the appointment of General Amos Thomas as executive secretary of the advisory committee. Raymond V. Darby, chairman of the board, stated that because of the wonderful service rendered by the existing committee in bringing to fruition the legislation necessary to permit the creation of the Air Pollution Control District, the board appointed all of the existing members of this committee, and authorized the appointment of five additional members, one to be from each supervisory district, and one from the county at large. The board named Dr. Louis C. McCabe, director of the Air Pollution Control District as such member at large.

Divorce Fee Raise Asked
