EDUCATION INVESTMENT BUT A 'COKE A DAY'

Education is an investment, while crime and charity are an expense, Dr. C. C. Trillingham, county superintendent of Schools, declared yesterday.

"The expense of crime and charity," Dr. Trillingham said, "may be assessed by investing more in public education as a preventive."

He pointed out that the American people, as quoted by J. Edgar Hoover, are paying 300 percent more for crime than for public education.

He also pointed out that the charity, bill of Los Angeles county for 1947-48 is \$101,433,435, which is \$5,267,202 more than is being spent for public education this year.

"The price each citizen of Los Angeles county pays for the education of youth from kindergarten through junior college is but a 'coke a day,'" Dr. Trillingham said.

Dr. Trillingham stated that the average current school cost per elementary pupil in Los Angeles county was 7 cents per day, or about 12 cents per pupil per hour for 1946-47. "This amount," said the superintendent, "is only a fraction of the cost of hiring a baby-sitter."

The superintendent further revealed that the total average cost per elementary pupil per year, including all instructional service, health examinations and transportation, amounted to only \$24.84 during 1946-47.

"The current annual cost to

the taxpayers of all education, including kindergarten, elementary, junior high, senior high, physically handicapped, emergency schools, junior college and adult education, amounted to \$24.88 per person in Los Angeles county last year—making about 6 cents, or the price of a "coke" per day.

"The superintendent stated that these comparisons are based upon the amount of money spent by all city and rural school districts in the county, which totals \$96,168,232.86, as divided by the October, 1947 estimate of 3,849,380 population furnished by the Los Angeles County Regional Planning Commission.
