### MGM Picks Torrance for Filming 'Shooting' Scene in New Movie

There probably are a lot of Torrance people and some Texans, too, who would be willing to give Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer an argument about their opinion that the Palms Verdes Hills look like Texas.

Nevertheless the movie company recently selected a gully in the hills south of the municipal airport to film a hunting scene in the picture, "The Stratton Story," because the locale looked like parts of the Lone Star State.

The film is based on the life of "Monty" Stratton, the former big-league pitching star with the Chicago White Sox. At the peak of his career, with a brilliant future ahead of him, he shot himself in the leg while hunting on his Texas ranch at the end of the 1938 baseball season. The leg had to be amputated, yet in 1946 he came back to pitch in the East Texas League for Sherman, and won 18 games while losing only four.

After overcoming that handicap, he was named the "Most Courageous Athlete of the Year." Stratton was with the movie company during the filming on

### BILL URGES SCHOOL TAX FOR TRAILER RESIDENTS

Lomita's considerable trailer park population were in the tax spotlight today in a bill introduced in the state legislature by Assemblyman Glenn Anderson.

Anderson is the author of Assembly Bill 1455 which proposes to exact a "fair share" of school expense from trailer house residents by doing two things:

- 1) Setting a minimum of \$10 a year for registration and licensing of trailer coaches.
- 2) Setting up a method of distributing the proceeds of the tax so that school districts would get a share.

"We have had complaints from school authorities particularly in distressed districts that parents of children coming from trailer coach homes should pay far more toward the upkeep of the schools than they do now," Anderson stated.

"A man with two children living in a trailer coach does not pay nearly his share of school costs as does the man next door living in a house. This bill seeks to equalize the situation." Of the proceeds from the trailer coach tax collected by the State, \$3 would go to the State with the balance to be distributed as follows: 60 per cent would go to the city or county in which the trailer is located, and 40 per cent to the school districts to be distributed by the County Treasurer. There is a formula for dividing the money as between elementary, high school and junior college districts.

Anderson said the bill has the support of the California Motor Court and Trailer Park Owners Association. The bill is scheduled to be heard before the Assembly Revenue and Tax Committee today.


