Kathryn Buffington, pianist and teacher, whose studio is 1434 Post avenue just returned from San Francisco where the National Convention of Music Teachers was held. More than a thousand teachers were delegates to the convention, which held its first session on the Pacific Coast. Founded in 1876, the National Association is now in its 73rd year.

Many significant meetings were held and many noted musicians attended. E. Robert Schmitz, noted pianist and educator, spoke at the convention on the subject: "What Debussy and Ravel Told Me About Their Piano Music." Mrs. Buffington was introduced to the great pianist at the end of the meeting.

Mrs. Buffington also attended many sessions on "accreditation," credit for high school students of the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades.

Students studying with an accredited teacher receive credit on their report cards and are allowed a free period in which to take their lessons. The Torrance teacher learned that such credit was being given in California, Montana, Idaho, as well as Oregon and Washington.




