

Beverly Hills Takes Top Spot In First Invitational Track Meet

Beverly Hills came out on top of the Torrance Invitational track meet held at Torrance High Friday afternoon followed by Gardena while Torrance and El Segundo tied for third place. The affair was climaxed with a host of records being broken. Torrance trounced all competition in the Bee division with more points than their opponents combined. The local Cees lost a heartbreaker in their class as they were edged out by Beverly Hills and Gardena by a 41 7/10, 41 4/10, 40 7/10 margin. Bill Storum led the Normans as he set a new Beverly Hills record in the high jump. His teammate John Wolcott also broke the Beverly record and the track record with a pole vault of 12 ft. 7 1/2 inches. Gil Avalos and Jack Hood paced the Tartar cinder.

men as they captured the low hurdles and the 880. The Torrance Bee team moved a step closer in their quest for the Bay title as they outran all opposition to win by a convincing margin. Milo Goettsch, star Bee hurdler, broke the Torrance High record, the track record, and tied the Southern California standard as he sped over the barriers in 8.9. Goettsch also took the low hurdles and the shot put with a terrific toss of 49 ft. 2 in. which would have cracked the record one week earlier.

Other Bee standouts were Dave Baker in the 220, Jack Dean in the pole vault, Bill Wernette in the high jump and broad jump, Ron Higgins and Jack Hoffman in the high jump, and Jack Stevens in his first 660 race of the season. Armals Dandoy was high point man for the Cees with a twin in the 660 and high jump. The first four finishers in each event were presented ribbons.
