## Those More Than 65 Urged To Check Benefits

To help them protect their full social security benefit rights, the Social Security Administration is issuing a special call to workers and former workers who have reached the age of 65. It was announced today by J. G. Bretherton, manager of the Long Beach Field office.

Any person covered by the Social Security Act may file his claim at age 65 even though he is still working, according to Bretherton. Of course, the eligible wage earner may not receive benefits while he is working in a job covered by the social security program. But by filing application he can prevent any possible loss of benefits in the future. If he keeps putting off making a claim, he may lose some monthly payments to which he would otherwise be entitled.

### Walteria School Growth Doubles In One Year

Since this time last year, the Walteria Elementary School has doubled its school population, according to D. Boone Kirks, principal. Approximate enrollment at this time last year was 110 students, while the present enrollment is nearing 250 pupils, he said. If all eligible kindergarten students were enrolled, the figure would be much higher, he added.

Nearby housing projects and growth in Walteria itself are believed responsible for the record increase.

A teacher will be added to the staff when school begins after vacation making the second addition to the teaching staff since Jan. 26, when the large first grade was divided into two classes, Kirks added.

Enrollment is expected to increase sharply when additional homes in Hollywood Riviera and on Ocean avenue in Walteria are occupied.
