**Bid To Develop Alondra Golf Course Studied**

County Golf Architect William P. Bell of Pasadena has been instructed by County Manager Wayne R. Allen to study an offer from the Meadowlark Golf club of Orange county to make a 10-year lease on the county-owned Alondra Park links.

C. B. Hollingsworth of Long Beach proposes to spend \$210,000 to complete the 124-acre golf course, which was 70 per cent finished by WPA a decade ago.

The Alondra Park course would charge fees comparable to those now required at Fox Hills, Rancho, Western and Griffith Park.

**Lions Honor Army Day**

If the United States forces had been able to occupy Germany in the final days of World War II, the present crisis with Russia would not exist, George Brown, deputy governor of District 4-D Lions International, told members of the Torrance Lions Club Tuesday meeting in Daniels cafe.

Honoring Army Day, Governor Brown traced the origin of the day from World War II, in which he served, to the present day when the nation is facing possibility of another conflict. He declared that Russia is not able to fight against a technical nation such as the United States, but stressed the importance of being prepared with adequate forces for any developments.

**Mayor Praises Salvation Army Salvage Drive**

Mayor J. Hugh Sherfey of Torrance, chairman of this city's "Salvage Week" campaign of the Salvation Army's social service department, stated of this week that "the more a person knows about the ideals and friendly helpfulness" of this branch of Salvation Army work, "the more a man, or woman, feels like wanting to say something and do something in its behalf."

It will help put men back to work and "back on their feet." Moreover, it will keep the social service department carrying on and expanding its commendable program.
