Joseph R. White, 66, of 1416 Beech avenue, veteran employee of the purchasing department of The National Supply Company, died Tuesday, April 6, in Torrance Memorial hospital where he had been admitted the previous day for treatment and observation.

A native of Ohio, the deceased is survived by his widow, Mrs. Aileen White, of the home address, who has been undergoing treatment at Seaside hospital, Long Beach.

Mr. White entered the employ of National Supply at the Toledo plant in April, 1916 and has been a Torrance resident since 1937 when he was transferred to the Torrance plant.

As Torrance Herald went to press funeral services had not been completed, according to White and Day Mortuary, Redondo Beach.

## KERSEY'S TROUBLES MAY HAVE RESULTED FROM LOCAL SCHOOL

Possibility that the decision of the Los Angeles Board of Education not to rehire Vierling Kersey as superintendent of schools when his contract expires Jan. 31 may have resulted from withdrawal of Torrance schools from Los Angeles School District was seen in a statement Friday of Lawrence L. Larrabee, member of the Los Angeles Board of Education.

"This is not a sudden decision," Larrabee, former president of the board commenting upon the announcement that Kersey would not be rehired, "It is the result of a situation that has been growing more difficult in the recent past—I'd say about the last two years. We just felt that the best interests of the school system called for a change in leadership."

It was two years ago that the final drive to withdraw Torrance schools from Los Angeles was undertaken, spearheaded and directed by the Torrance Herald, and carried to a successful conclusion.
