

PRESBYTERIANS TO HEAR 'LOCAL OPTION' ADDRESS

First of a series of special lectures requested by Lomita citizens will be delivered at the Community Presbyterian church, 2154 245th street at 9:30 and 11 a.m. next Sunday "California's Liquor Problem—Better Legislative Control."

According to an announcement by the Rev. John E. Orr, pastor, guest speaker will be William L. Miller, nationally known lecturer, who will talk under the auspices of the California Temperance Federation and the California Council of Protestant Churches.

Miller will advocate support at the November election of the Local Control of Intoxicating Liquors initiative measure and will outline the battle to place it on the ballot, successfully concluded last month.

He will point out the benefits of the measure which gives to the governing bodies of cities

and counties the right to pass on or veto the issuance, transfer or renewal of all types of liquor licenses.

In addition, Miller will describe what he terms "present ineffective and biased methods of liquor control now being practiced by the State Board of Equalization."

Progress of voters registration campaigns now held in more than 1500 Lomita and Southland churches to help pass the measure will also be described.


