

# Wets Asked To Name Insurance Beneficiaries

A large percentage of veterans have failed to name a beneficiary for their National Service Life Insurance under the revised law, it was announced today by J. G. Caldwell, director of the Torrance Area Veterans Service Center.

Caldwell said many servicemen did not bother to designate beneficiaries by name at the time their G. I. insurance was written as the law provided for automatic payment of the insurance to the insured's closest relatives. Now the insurance is paid in a lump sum to the estate of the insured unless a beneficiary is specified by name. As part of an estate, insurance loses its identity and is subject to laws governing estates, including claims of creditors, administrators' fees and court costs.

If the insured has selected the installment method of payment it is important that the insured also name a contingent beneficiary, Caldwell explained, otherwise the insurance may go to the estate of the primary beneficiary.

To avoid delay in receiving premium receipts, veterans should make their premium payments in self-addressed envelopes provided with each premium notice, Caldwell said. Another important item to keep the record straight is for the insured to notify the Veterans Administration of every change of address.

Veterans may obtain complete information on conversion and other insurance items in the Torrance Area Veterans Service Center located at 1339 Post ave.



# Plans Made For Scout-O-Rama At L.A. Stadium

Three hundred Scout Troops, Cub Packs and Senior Units of the Los Angeles Area Council have gone into action in developing live demonstrations for the great Scout-O-Rama to be held at Gilmore Stadium April 30 and May 1.

Metal Work exhibits will show every process used in working with Copper. They will also show many beautiful pieces of work which have already been completed. Other booths will include crafts of all types such as model airplane building, soap carving, tin can craft, bead work and hundreds of other crafts. More than 170 Merit Badges will be demonstrated.

One Troop on the Dairying Merit Badge will actually demonstrate mechanical milking and the process of milk through separators, churning, etc., including the care of the animals. Other Merit Badges will be blacksmithing, angling, reptile study, automobilg, and many others.

The Show is shaping up beautifully, stated Fred J. Tabery, general chairman of the Scout-O-Rama.

More than 18,000 tickets already have been sold, according to Jim Buchner, attendance chairman. Clem C. Glass, chairman of the staging committee, reports that a swell Stage Show has been lined up with a U. control gas model airplane. There will be a mounted explorer post, and a real fancy hula dance will be put on by a Pack. Scout units will be permitted to move into Gilmore Stadium after 10:00 a.m. Friday morning in order to set up their booths and go into operation for the first show. There will be three shows; Friday, April 30 from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m., Saturday May 1 from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. and from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m.

The price of admission is 50c. The main purpose of the show is to give the people of Los Angeles County an opportunity to see what the Boy Scout Program is and what it does for boys.

# R.F.C. Will Consider Harbor Loan

The Reconstruction Finance Corporation has informed Rep. Cecil King that it is leaving door open for a possible loan to enable the cities of Redondo Beach, Manhattan Beach and Hermosa Beach to construct an Inland Yacht Harbor after preliminary discussions were held on the project in Los Angeles. King said Hector Haight of the R.F.C.'s regional office in Los Angeles reported to R.F.C. here that spoke-men for the yacht harbor submitted definite plans for the project but as yet have not completed legal research for the establishment of a sponsoring organization.

The local planners have obtained R.F.C. circulars and applications and the R.F.C. expects the applications to be submitted at some future date. King said it was his impression that much spade work still had to be done on the project locally before R.F.C. can step in with financial help, if at all.

However, the R.F.C. pointed out that it is possible to make loans for community projects.

In 1933, the R.F.C. made a federal loan for the development of a yacht harbor at Annapolis, Md.

The yacht harbor was sponsored by private interests and the R.F.C. loan was made on the basis that it was a project beneficial to the public interest.

# Candidates For Assembly Are Announced

Assemblyman Vincent L. Thomas, representative of the 68th district, which includes Torrance, Lomita and the Harbor district, for the past three terms, will face three opponents in the consolidated primary election in June 1. Frank Jordan, secretary of state, announced today. Thomas also was listed among the candidates as delegates to the Democratic presidential convention. For the assembly race, he has filed on both the Democrat and Republican tickets.

Other candidates are Chester Culp, 835 W. 19th st., Democrat; James McDermott, 1729 1/2 E. Pacific Coast Hwy., Wilmington, Democrat; and James F. Quinn, 1029 Bayview ave., Wilmington, Democrat and Republican.

Cecil R. King, 17th District Congressman, will have five opponents. The incumbent, Democrat, also has cross field. Others are James G. Caldwell, 22120 Moneta ave., Torrance, Democrat; Eugene Calkins, 840 W. 77th st., Los Angeles, Republican; L. Gayle Warwick, 428 W. 164th St., Gardena, Republican and Democrat; Edwin Reinheimer, 5125 S. Manhattan pl., Los Angeles, Republican; Louis Stark Hawthorne, Democrat and Independent Progressive.
