

VFW Disputes Lien for \$361

Torrance Post 3251 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars has brought a complaint in quiet title against Chester Walsh, head of W. R. Concrete Company, to have a mechanic's lien Walsh has obtained against their building at Washington and Apple streets voided. Walsh had agreed to put a foundation under metal buildings owned by the Post and formerly used as medical barracks, completing the job June 6 and being paid \$3400, according to the suit filed by Atty. W. E. Kalbfleisch. But August 2 Walsh filed a mechanics' lien for labor and materials furnished to the post in the construction work, and demanding payment of \$361.97. This sum, the Post said, is a "cloud" upon its legal property. It denies owing Walsh the money, asks Superior Court to declare the lien void and to decree that Walsh has no interest in the property.
