

## Two Sessions at Waleria School Slated

With 72 children pre-registered for kindergarten and heavy enrollment anticipated in the second and third grades, Waleria elementary school will have two half-day sessions for these two groups with the opening of school next Monday, according to D. Boone Kirks, principal.

First, fourth, fifth and sixth grades will start the year on a regular session program, but how long they can continue depends on the growth of each class. Early in 1949 it is hoped to have another elementary school opened to accommodate children of the Riviera and Seaside Ranchos district.

Younger kindergarten children from 4 1/2 to 5 years will go to school in the morning; those 5 to 5 1/2 years will attend in the afternoon. Information is being mailed out to parents of kindergarten, second and third grade children as to which session they are to attend, Kirks said.

Following is the schedule: Kindergarten morning session: Children will ride the school bus arriving before 9 a.m. with the full-day pupils. They will return home at noon by bus. Afternoon session: Arrive by bus at noon with the afternoon pupils of the second and third grades. They will return home with the fourth, fifth and sixth grades, being supervised after dismissal at 3:15 o'clock and leaving the school grounds at 3:30.

First grade—regular session: Arrive at 9 a.m. and return home as soon after the 2:10 dismissal as the bus can make its run.

Second and third grades—morning session: Hours 8 to 12, returning home at noon as soon as the bus arrives with the pupils attending the afternoon session. Afternoon session: Hours 12:15 to 4:15 p.m. Children attending this session will be picked up by the bus before 12 o'clock.

Fourth, fifth and sixth grades: Regular full-day sessions, starting at 9 a.m., with dismissal at 3:30 p.m. as in other schools.




