This Machine Does Everything But Counterfeit Money!

.....To err is human, but for the mechanical brain recently installed at the Torrance National Bank to err it is a "miracle" and miracles just don't happen.

The machine, a mass of buttons, tapes, and gears, performs the dual function of a mechanical brain and a financial scale. Main accomplishment of the elaborate electrical device is its ability to keep the bank in balance at all times.

Manufactured by the National Cash Register company, the machine records every financial transaction including incoming and outgoing checks, money orders, commercial and saving deposits and all other bank transactions.

"The machine has real value to the community," said James W. Post, "in that it means better and faster service to customers since tellers now are freed from much time-consuming detail work."

The apparatus is similar in appearance to a cash register except there is no money drawer. A wire to the left of the keys contains several bins with gates covering the openings. As a transaction is recorded on the machine the proper gate slips open to receive the deposit slip.

Zoning Plan Start Seen


