None was injured seriously.

Haldale Pupils To Visit Bank.

After returning to school the children will have a discussion about their trip in preparation for a written essay about what they have learned at the bank. The children also plan to make oral reports, posters, and write letters of appreciation to the bank manager.

School savings plans have a far-reaching and beneficial effect, Principal Amanda Bonwell said, urging parents to cooperate with teachers in encouraging children to set aside their coins for the purpose of opening bank accounts.






