### Valley Forge Returning With Four Local Men

The first aircraft carrier to launch air attacks against the North Koreans will become the first carrier to complete three Korean tours today when the USS Valley Forge docks at the Naval Air Station, San Diego.

Aboard will be four Torrance men: Vincent G. Lovell, airman, 1541 W. 215th St.; Eugene E. Jones, seaman, 122 E. 223rd St.; James A. Pizer, storekeeper, third class, 1563 W. 224th St.; and Johan Lynso, chief intercommunications technician, 317 E. 220th St.

Two years ago today, July 3, 1950, the "Happy Valley" appeared on the combat line off Korea, the only carrier in the area with Carrier Air Group aboard. That was the first day the Navy's Panther jets were in combat.

The carrier returned to the United States on Dec. 1, 1950, but was here only five days before starting back. She returned again April 7, 1951 and remained here until last October when she returned for the third Korean duty.
