

Three Torrance Men Serving On Battleship Iowa

Among the 2200 crewmen serving aboard the battleship USS Iowa in Korean waters are three Torrance men, Charles K. Kohoutek, seaman, USN, of 1532 W. 203rd St.; Roy E. Cameron, seaman, USN, husband of Mrs. Frieda Cameron of 20122 Figueroa St., and Francis A. Campbell, fireman apprentice, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. T. H. Anderson of 2035 Kathy Way. Since leaving "mothballs" to

relieve her sister battleship, the USS Wisconsin, the Iowa has continued to bombard the communists in round-the-clock support of United Nations ground troops. During her first month of combat, the 45,000-ton Iowa hurled more than 1000 rounds of one-ton 16-inch projectiles, and over 3000 rounds of 5-inch shells on Red installations along the west coast of North Korea. The Iowa is the flagship of the Commander, Seventh Fleet.
