Have Discharge Papers Recorded, Official Warns

Korea veterans who apply for mustering out pay authorized by the new federal "GI Bill" are strongly cautioned by Miss Helen K. Dill, director of the Torrance Area Community Chest-sponsored Veterans Service Center, to have their discharge papers officially recorded by their county before sending them in to the armed services.

Application forms for the mustering out pay are available in her office at 1103 Sartori Ave. Most servicemen discharged on or after June 27, 1950, with at least 60 days of service are eligible for the payments.

"The armed services are requiring that a veteran's application for mustering out pay be accompanied by his Report of Separation Form DD 214," Miss Dill commented. "There's always a danger that it may be lost or delayed in return. Every veteran should protect himself by

having his separation document registered by his county recorder. This is a free county service."

The serviceman's original separation notice is also his "passport" in applying for many other federal and state benefits where proof of veteran status must be shown, Miss Dill explained.

"Loss of this document may cause serious delays in filing for many entitlements if the discharge isn't legally recorded," she declared.
